Sheriff Phil R. Stammitti is once again offering the Lorain County Sheriff's Citizen Partnership Academy.

The Lorain County Sheriff's Citizen Partnership Academy is a 10 week course designed to inform and share with citizens of Lorain County the functions of the Lorain County Sheriff's Office, along with other aspects of the Lorain County Judicial System.

Classes will begin on Wednesday, April 3rd 2019 and continue for 10 weeks with graduation on Wednesday June 5th 2019. All classes are held on Wednesdays from 6:00pm till approximately 8:30 pm. During these sessions we will have hands on instruction in fingerprinting, firearms, driving and more. We will also have presentations from other offices associated with the judicial system.


There will be approximately 20 spaces available on a first come first serve basis. Registration applications should be returned no later than March 23rd 2019.
