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2013 ANNUAL REPORT HIGHLIGHTS

- ★ Commitments Increased by 1.7% from 7,964 in 2012 to 8,098 in 2013.
- ★ State Charges Increased by 2.2% from 7,779 in 2012 to 7,951 in 2013.
- ★ Ordinance Charges Decreased by 20.5% from 185 in 2012 to 147 in 2013.
- ★ Funds Generated from Ordinance Cases Increased by 37.4% from \$53,550 in 2012 to \$73,575 in 2013.
- ★ Male Bookings Decreased by 6% from 6,180 in 2012 to 6,142 in 2013.
- ★ Female Bookings Increased by 9.6% from 1,784 in 2012 to 1,956 in 2013.
- ★ Felony Bookings Increased by 7.6% from 3,182 in 2012 to 3,424 in 2013.
- ★ Misdemeanor Bookings Decreased by 1.6% from 4,704 in 2011 to 4,630 in 2013.
- ★ Parole / Probation Violations Decreased by 30.9% from 78 in 2012 to 54 in 2013.
- ★ The Average Daily Inmate Population Increased by 2.2% from 415 in 2012 to 424 in 2013.
- ★ Inmate Releases Increased by 2% from 7,960 in 2012 to 8,123 in 2013.
- ★ Funds Generated by the Inmate Work Release Program Increased by 715% from \$2,064 in 2012 to \$16,836 in 2013.
- ★ Inmate Telephone Contributions Decreased by 9.7% from \$141,220 in 2012 to \$127,426 in 2013.
- ★ Continued Active Accreditation from the National Commission on Correctional Health Care.

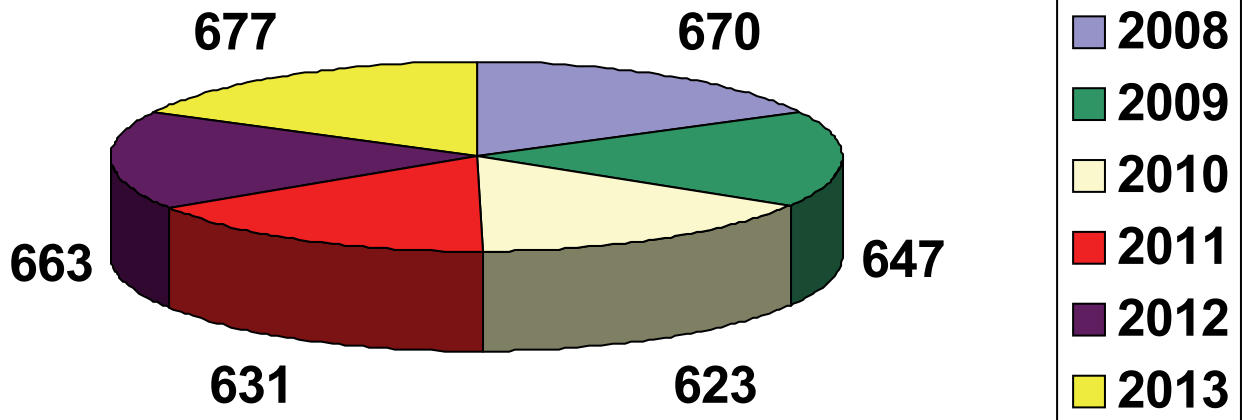

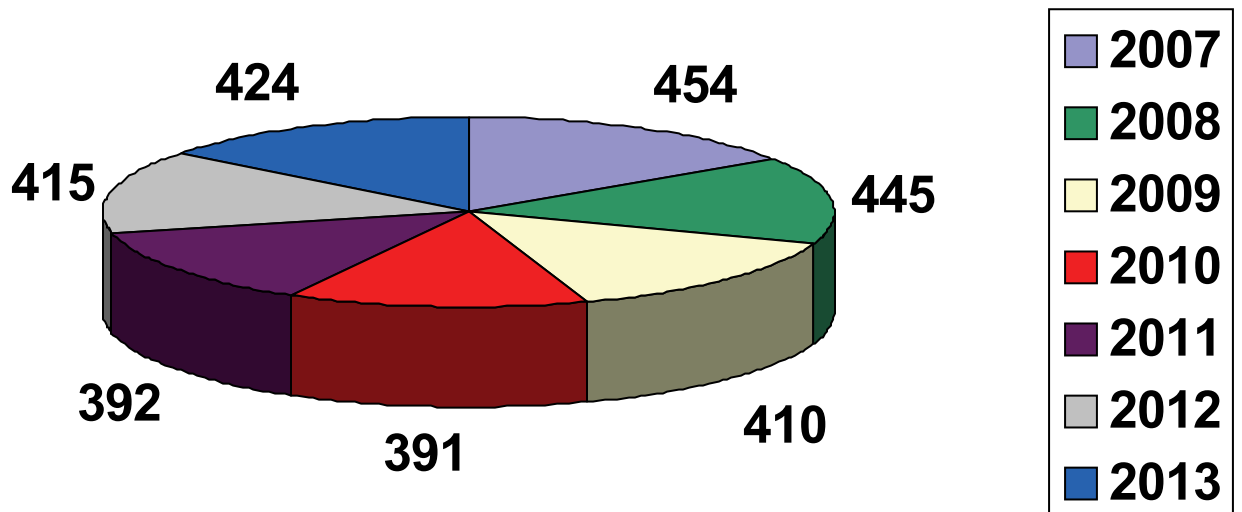
AVERAGE YEARLY INMATE RELEASE CHART

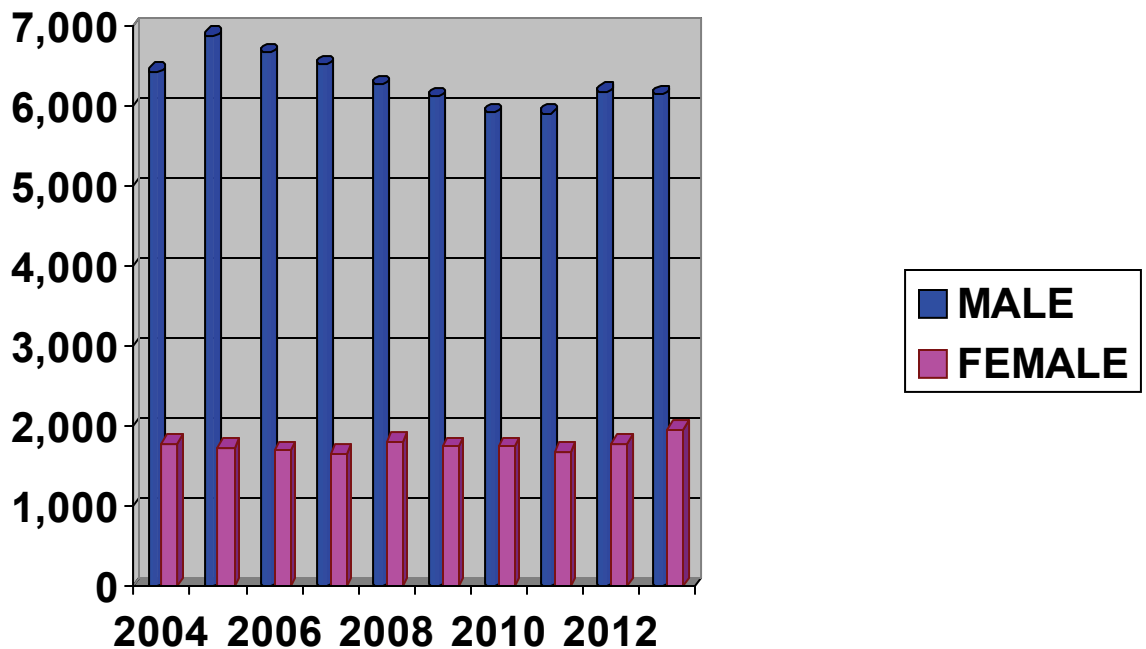

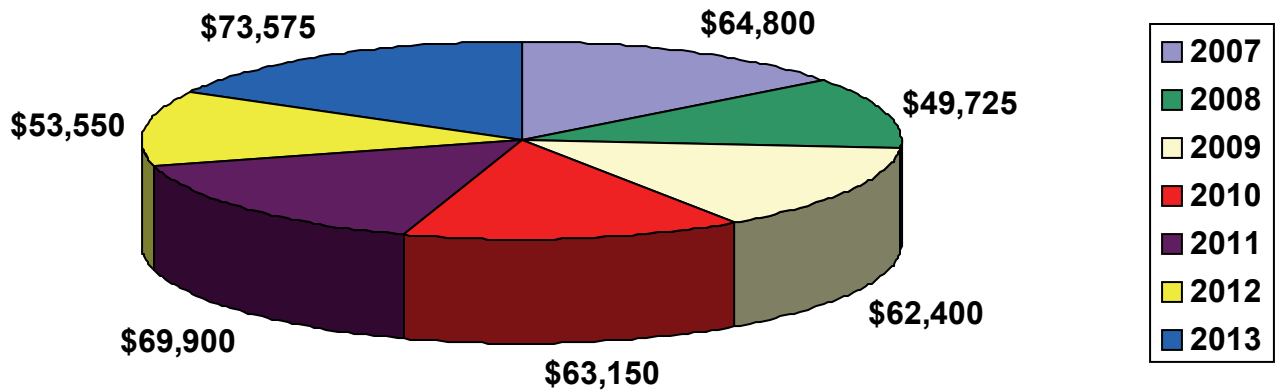
INMATE GENDER CHART

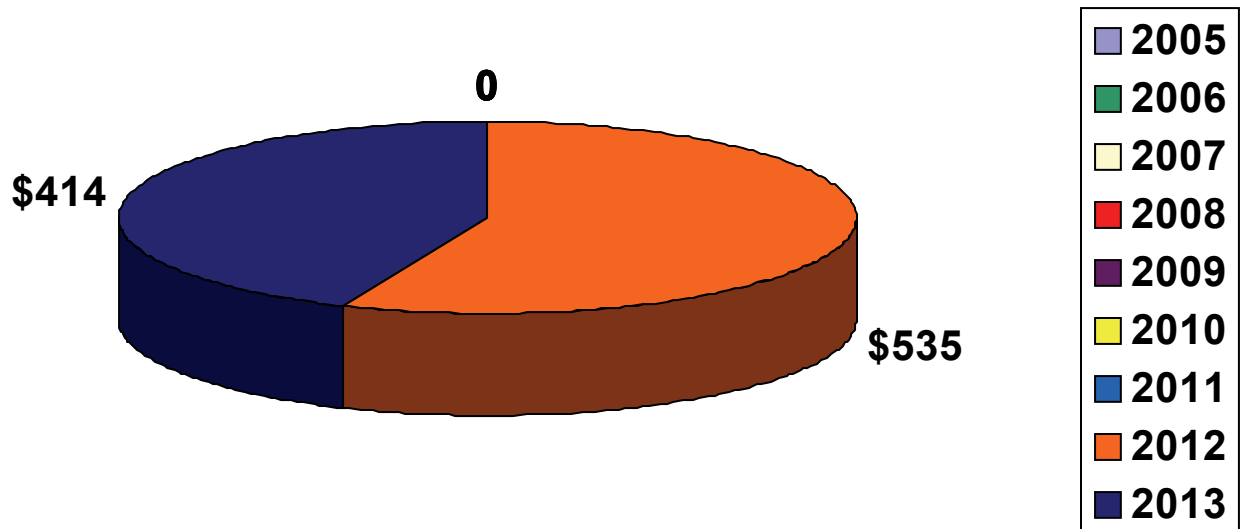
INMATE MEDICAL CO-PAY

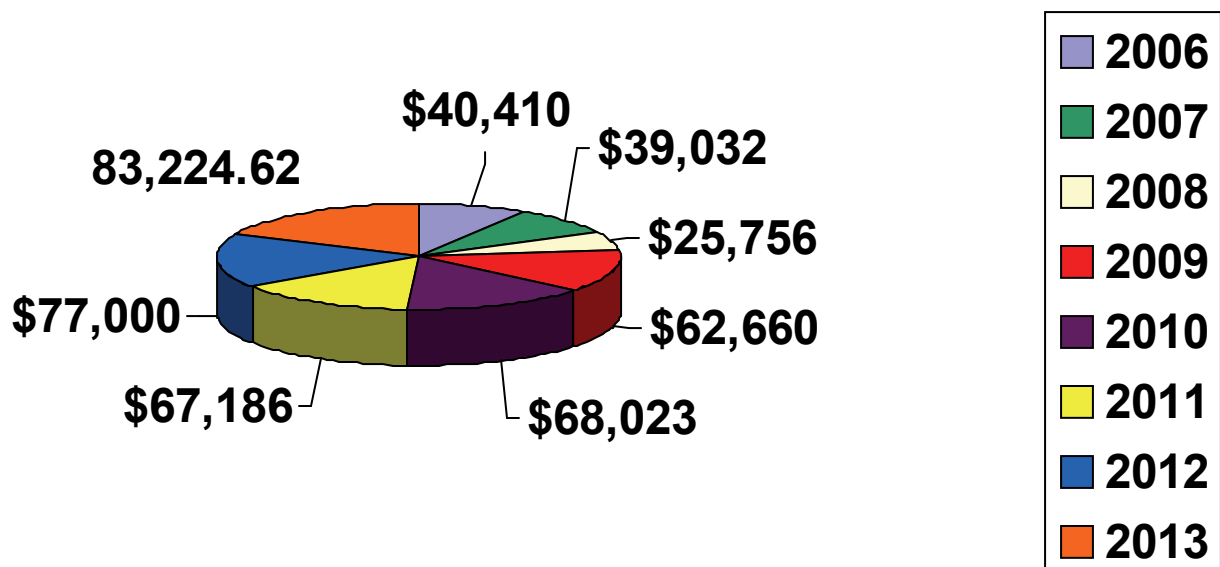
YEARLY INMATE COMMISSARY CHART

The Lorain County Sheriff's Office has contracted ARAMARK Food Services to provide commissary to the inmate population. Inmates are permitted to purchase hygiene, writing, food items and other approved products. The Sheriff's Office earns 22% commission of the total items purchased weekly.

Per the Ohio Revised Code profits forwarded to the Lorain County Sheriff's Office must be placed into a special inmate welfare and recreational account. Expenditures from the inmate welfare and recreational account may only be allocated for items that solely and directly benefit the inmate population.

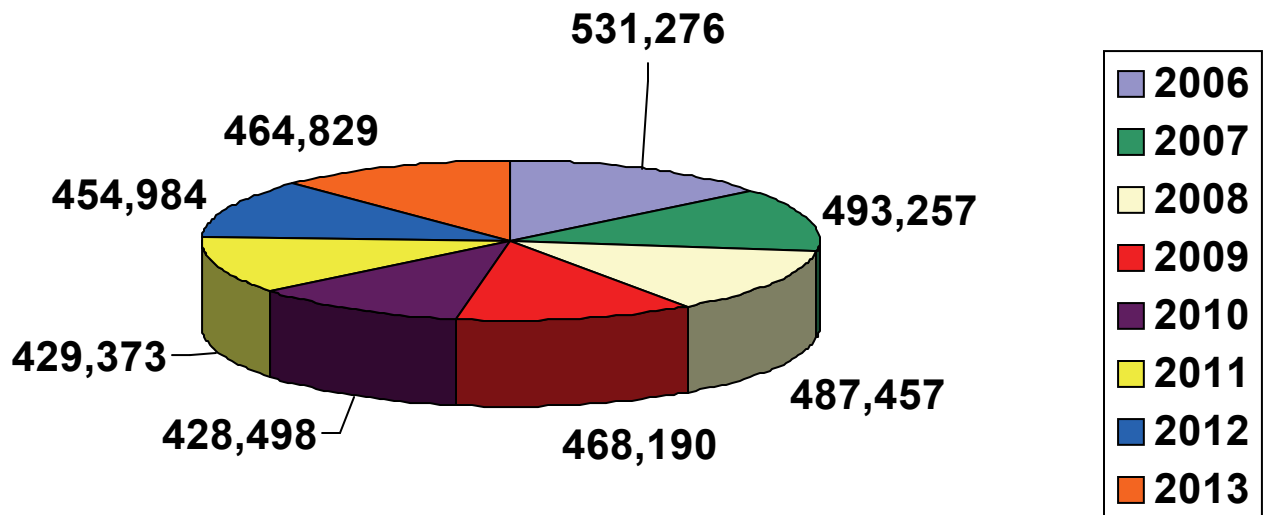
Items routinely purchased from this account include: Televisions, exercise equipment, recreational equipment, hair clippers and educational aids.

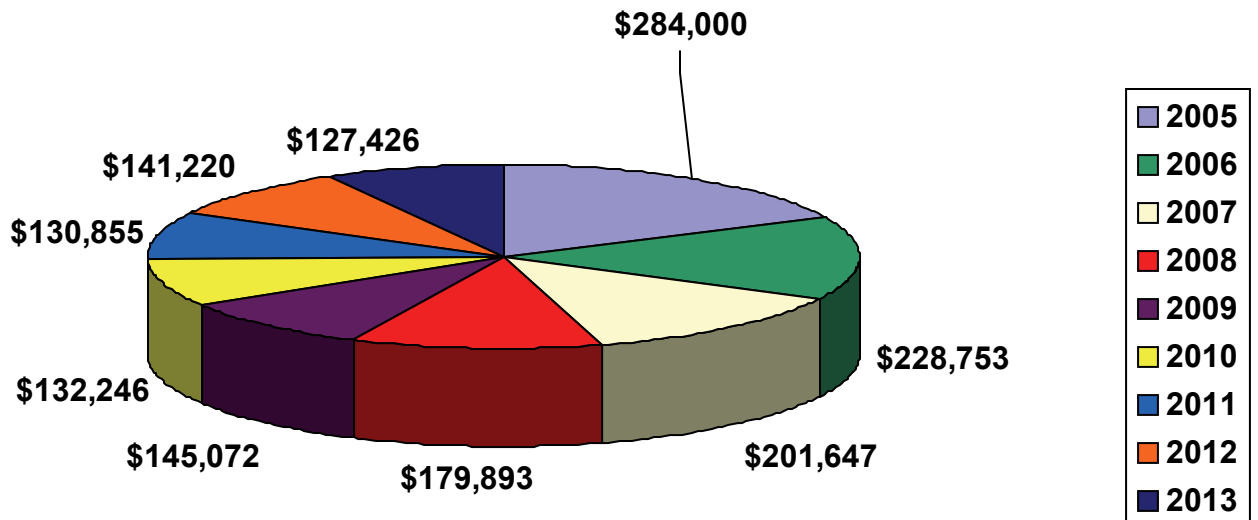

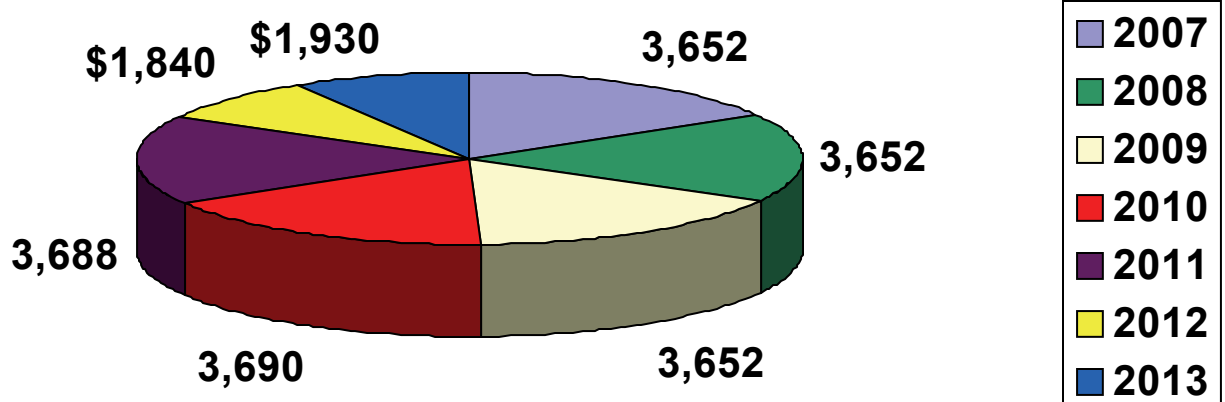

Inmates sentenced to the work release program are permitted to maintain their employment by being allowed to leave the facility for scheduled work. Inmates are randomly checked by jail staff to assure they are at their place of employment .

Inmates who are accepted into the work release program are required to pay one hours wage per day to the Lorain County Sheriff's Office to help defray the cost of their incarceration.
